CIRCULAR

- 2. Hoardings, banners, posters etc. are to be displayed at prominent locations and pamphlets, handouts etc., to be distributed on preventive vigilance activities/whistle blower mechanism and other anti-corruption measures;
- 3. Workshops/sensitization programmes for employees are to be conducted;
- 4. Various competitions such as debates, quiz, elocution, essay writing, cartoons/poster competition on moral values, ethics, good governance etc. are to be conducted for the employees and their families, students of school/colleges etc., on items relating to anti-corruption;
- 5. Organizational website may be used for dissemination of employees/visitors' oriented information and avenues available for grievance redressal;
- 6. Social media, electronic and print media may be used for spreading awareness etc.
