परिपत्र/CIRCULAR

It has been observed that some of the employees of NCSM are occasionally posting/endorsing comments on various social media viz., Facebook page, Whatsapp group, Twitter handle etc., adversely criticizing the policies or actions of the Government. In this regard, attention of Rule 9 of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, as adopted by NCSM, is drawn which stipulates as under:-

"No Government servant shall, in any radio broadcast, telecast through any electronic media or in any document published in his own name or anonymously, pseudonymously or in the name of any other person or in any communication to the press or in any public utterance, make any statement or fact or opinion which has the effect of an adverse criticism of any current or recent policy or action of the Central Government or a State Government".

As such, posting/endorsing comments on various social media adversely criticizing the policies or actions of the Government will be in violation of Rule 9 of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964. All concerned are, therefore, requested to take a note of the above provision of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, as adopted by NCSM and refrain from posting/endorsing comments on social and other electronic media adversely criticizing the policies or actions of the Government.
