A. REGISTRATION

- 1. Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online Bidders Enrolment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- 2. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.) with their profile.
- 5. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC's to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6. Biddersmay then log-in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

B. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- There are various search options built in the CPP Portal to facilitate bidders to search active

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 2. Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3. Bidders, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. - 4. D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 2. The bidders have to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 3. Bidders have to select the payment option as "online or offline" to pay the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) and enter detail of the instrument.
- 4. Bidders should submit the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. 1. INTRODUCTION:

- i. Brief Information of National Museum: National Museum, the prime cultural organization of India, was inaugurated on 15th August 1949 at President House and moved to its permanent location at Janpath on 18th December 1960. NM started with the mission of three C's i.e. 'Collection', 'Conservation' and 'Communication' through its various programmes. It has 29 permanent galleries, on three floors, representing the museum's diverse collection, which represent the rich heritage of India. Time to time museum collaborates with the cultural organizations of India and outside India to hold national and international exhibitions, workshops and seminars. NationalMuseumisvisitedbyover4lakhspeopleeveryyear.
- ii. The proposed work is under the renovation plan of National Museum. The reception lobby of the Museum is planned to give a complete digital experience to a visitor, wherein the information about the important museum galleries and objects will be given to the visitors through various modern digital gadgets. A brief orientation will also be given to the visitors adjacent to the Reception Lobby before they start the journey of the Museum.
- iii. NCSM therefore invites Tenders from Company/Firm/Agency/Consortium with adequate experience, sound financial background and proven capabilities of creating digital experience using most modern digital gadgets and techniques and have the proficiency in story telling using digital media at museums/Art Galleries/exhibition/public space
- **iv.** Bidders who are interested to participate should meet the eligibility criteria and submit their duly completed Tenders along with all the required documents in support of their eligibility qualification.
- v. If at any stage, it comes to the notice of NCSM that any successful/qualified bidder had misrepresented the facts/falsely claimed any qualification while submitting his tender or at any time subsequently, the agency will be disqualified. And in any such instance, NCSM also reserves the right to take any further action against such bidder under law.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Company/Firm/Agency/Consortium shall have the experience of implementing digital experience using most modern digital gadgets and techniques and have the proficiency in story telling using digital media.
- ii. The bidder could be an Individual, Limited Company/Corporation, Proprietary Firm, Partnership etc. Consortium or Joint Venture are allowed to bid for the Works.
- iii. The bidders should have minimum experience of **5 years** since their establishment. For establishing the same, the bidder should submit copies of **work orders** issued on them as well as copies of **work completion certificate** of the same work.
- iv. The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder (of the lead partner in case of consortium) for last three financial years(2019-20, 2018-19, and 2017-18) should be minimum **INR 7 Crore**.
- v. The Bidder should have the requisite work experience of **completing**similar projects during the last 5 years ending last day of month previous to the date of issuing of tender as per the details given below:

One similar work of value not less than **Rs. 5.50 Crore** of the estimated cost of work.

Two similar works each of value not less than **Rs. 4.25 Crore** of estimated cost of work.

Notes:

Here the **similar works*** means the work of "creating digital experience using most modern digital gadgets and techniques and have the proficiency in story telling using digital media in Museums and other public places".

The details of qualifying works/projects shall be furnished as per the proforma in**Annexure-D** and if required the bidder shall also facilitate inspection of the above qualifying project(s) by NCSM's officials to ascertain the performance of the system.

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission of bid or extended date of submission of bid.

vi. NCSM may inspect any of those at its discretion to verify the credentials of the bidder for the qualifying works/ projects indicated above for which the Bidder shall provide references (including Referee names and contact details) in respect of the projects implemented.

For the purposes of determining Conditions of Eligibility and for evaluating the Proposals under this tender, following projects shall be deemed as Eligible Projects - Similar works as mentioned in Notes under point (v) of Eligibility Criteria for Monument / Museum / Parks / Public Places/ / Memorial / Heritage places / Ethnic / Cultural spaces / and other similar places.

The bidder should provide documentary proof for the above in the form of a work order / supply order / contract document / completion report/ testimonials for completion.

 - Record for poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.

viii. Proof of Concept (PoC)

- a. The bidders may be advised to present a proof of concept (PoC) document i.e. scheme for creating the digital experience at the Reception Lobby of the National Museum using latest digital gadgets and techniques. The details of the lobby such as AUTOCAD drawings (plan and elevation) shall be shared with the applicants on request. Submission of PoC document is mandatory. Non submission of PoC document may lead to summarily rejection of bid.
- b. The equipment used in the concept should be as per the specifications mentioned in the BoQonly and the entire experience should be controlled **centrally**through a **suitable** server, content management software(CMS) and networked devices.
- c. The hardware and the software chosen should be of latest model and the **warranty** from OEM should be taken for 3 years and all licenses proposed should be licensed for lifetime.
- d. The bidder shall also submit any additional gadgets/equipment/software etc required to execute the Digital& Immersive Experience works as per their submitted proposal. However, they should take the cost of all additional requirement in the quoted price of the bidder.
- e. Further requirement if any regarding the presentation shall be communicated in due course.

Note: The bidder shall approach NCSM for required drawings. The bidders should be ready for the demonstration of Proof of concept (PoC) on short notice, say 3 days from the communication from NCSM.

3. SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The successful e-tenderer shall carry out and complete the works in every respect in accordance with this contract and in accordance with the directions of the officials and to the satisfaction of the officialsof NCSM/NM. The Officer in charge may from time to time issue further written instructions, detailed directions and explanations in regard to:

- (a) The variation or modification of the design, quality or quantity of works for the addition or omissions or substitution of any work.
- (b) Any discrepancy in the proposal or between the schedule of quantities and/or specifications.
- (c) The removal from the site of any material brought therein by the successful e-tenderer and the substitution of any other materials there from.
- (d) The removal and/or re-execution of any works executed by the successful e-tenderer.

- (e) The dismissal from the works of any persons employed thereupon.

- (j) The successful bidder shall submit the executable files along with the open source of all soft content developed for this project and shall not use these content for any other purpose with the permission of NM/NCSM
- (k) Copyright: All the software will be copyrighted with the NM Delhi/ NCSM and no copy will be distributed for any means to other vendors or organization or any promotional activity without any permission from NM Delhi/ NCSM.

All the content shall be free from any copyright violation and the successful bidder shall give an undertaking to NCSM/NM towards this.

(I) Successful E-Tenderer To Provide Everything Necessary

The successful e-tenderer shall provide everything necessary for the proper execution of the works according to the true intent and meaning of the specifications and bill of quantities taken together, whether the same may or may not be particularly described in the drawings or specifications or included in the bill of quantities, provided that the same is to be reasonably inferred there from and if he finds any discrepancy in the drawings or specifications and bill of quantities, he shall immediately refer the same to the Officer In charge who shall decide which shall be followed. Figured dimensions shall be followed in reference to scale.

(m) Rates

The rates quoted by the Successful e-tenderer shall be paid at net rates. He should include in his rates allowance for increase or decrease in the prices due to market fluctuation. He shall not be entitled to any separate amount on account of GST, other taxes, Labour Cess, duties etc. which are in force or will be enforced or enhanced by Government or local bodies during contract period or after e-tendering. Accepted e-tender rates shall not be changed due to changes in wages of labour either.

The rates considered in the respective items are inclusive of comprehensive maintenance of the entire system for a period of twoyears after completion of the defects liability period of 1 year post the actual satisfactory completion of the entire work in all sense. (Total comprehensive maintenance period of 3 years including Defect Liability period of 1 year)

(n) Quantities

The quantities have been given in schedule of quantities. However, if the bidder feels that some additional quantity for any item is required, that may be added in the breakup and cost due to variation should be taken into account in the final quote.

The e-tenderers shall be deemed to have given Balanced Rates for each item, irrespective of the quantities given. Also irrespective of variation in quantities to any extent the e-tenderer shall be paid at accepted contract rates only. NCSM reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities to any extent.

4. SCOPE OF WORK

NCSM/NM desires to provide a digital immersive experience using most modern digital gadgets and techniques and with interesting story telling using digital media, to the visitors of National Museum (NM), New Delhi. The entire space of the reception or entrance lobby and at other places inside the museum as decided by NM/NCSMneedsto be utilized to create the world class digital & immersive experience for the visitors. The scope of work, therefore, includes supply, installation, integration, networking, testing, commissioning of all the equipment along with the especially developed software (contentand CMS) for this purpose. The scope also includes training of 5 (five) NM personnel for day to day operation of the system.

Within the quoted rates, the successful bidder will also provide comprehensive maintenance services for the all the installed equipment and software/content by them for the defect liability period of one yearwithout any additional cost.

After the expiry of the defect liability period of one year, the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for two years will be executed with NM. This two years Comprehensive AMC is the part of the scope of work within the quoted rates by bidders.

The project/work is to be completed within **90 Days** from the date of issuance of the work order/LOI.

A. Major Components of the Scope of Work

- a. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development for 55 inch or more Transparent OLED Digital Signage Display including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables and displayenclosure for showcasing masterpiece Objects of NM the details of which will be provided by National Museum.
- b. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development for 5x2 grid thin bezel multi-touch LED Digital Display Wall using 46-48 inch LED digital signage including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables and display enclosure for interactive display of NMObjects the details of which will be provided by National Museum.
- c. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development for Large Indoor P 2.5mm LED wall with Holographic illusion (Pepper-Ghost Pyramidal Holographic display) including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables for display of video contenton National Museum and itsObjects for which information will be provided by National Museum.

- d. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development for Orientation Film by way of 3-Wall Projection Mapping Show using DLP Laser Projectors with necessary lenses including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables for giving brief information about all the galleries of National Museum, the brief write-up on which will be provided by National Museum.
- e. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development and Display systemfor Technology Engagement for each of the 10 galleries by using any two of the listed technologies as per annexure-I(e) including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables for giving detailed information about the masterpiece/selected Objects of the gallery, which will be provided by National Museum.
- f. Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of all Hardware, Software, Content Development for Central Content Device Management Software System including appropriate Media Server/Computer Server/CPU along with all cables and networking component for managing all the devices and contents that have been listed in this tender.
- g. The Content should be developed in such a way that it can also be deployed on National Museum Mobile App and National Museum website and can be integrated with Audio/Tour Guide Mobile App of National Museum.
- h. Quantity and detailed technical specifications of the items shall be as per Annexure-I of this tender document.
- i. Programming System, Integration & Soft Commissioning
 - i. System Integration and addressing of all equipment for ease of control.
 - Programming of shows of all installations to create various pre-set schemes, saved to a touch controller.
- j. Modifications/ Alterations: After the setup is soft commissioned, the same will be reviewed by the Client. Upon such review, if there be any suggestion in the concept/integration etc. received from the Client, will need to be incorporated (within reason) without any extra cost before the work is finally commissioned and taken over.
- k. Training to National Museum Staff
 - i. Provide training to the client/owner's staff including the day to day operation & maintenance with minor repairs.
 - ii. Hard copy of ready reckoner (Manual) for the daily operation, checking and diagnosis of day to day faults repairable by client staff should be provided
- 1. One Year Defect Liability Period and additional Two years of Comprehensive Annual Maintenance
 - i. The bidder will be required to provide comprehensive maintenance services for the subject digital experience system installed by them for the defect liability period of one year without any additional cost.

- ii. Prior to the expiry of the defect liability period of one year, the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for two years will be executed by the successful bidder with National Museum within the rates offered by them.
- iii. The successful bidder is supposed to maintain minimum spare at the site in order to keep the downtime less than 24 hrs and is required to complete the two years comprehensive AMC successfully.

B. Detailed guidelines of the scope of work:

- i. Two rectangular hall with dimensions as per drawing in **Annexure- J** shall be used for creating the digital experience. The entire work related to creating the desired shows, as listed in the BoQ given in **Annexure-I**includes supply of equipment (such as Transparent LED Display Panels, Large multi-touch video walls, indoor LED walls, Projectors, Pepperghost pyramidal Holographic display, related media servers/ Computer Server, sound systems, content management system, accessories, cables, software and content) and the allied works such as placement and installation of equipment, integrating the entire equipment through LAN as well as creation of content for all equipment as per the storyline given by National Museum.
- ii. The experience should be designed within the available built up area and there is no scope for any alteration of floor, ceiling, wall etc. of the hall. The site is an institution of national importance where any major alteration in the building is not possible and any installation is required to be done with utmost sensitivity and care, without damaging the interior of the building.
- iii. Supply and installation of projectors and mapping of projectors on the given area should be done in accordance with the directive of the OEM, for best results. This shall be in the scope of work.
- iv. Supply and installation of high performance Computer Server/Media Servers supporting Displays being used for playback of digital content and static imagery shall be in the scope of work. The vendor shall provide a user friendly Graphical User Interface to control entire system, including audio system, etc. from the same interface.
- v. Supply and installation of Data cabling to carry lossless video signals from amongst the sources viz. Computer Server and playback system to projectors and high speed data path network (if any) among computing and storage elements through fibre optic cables are also in the scope of the work. Any other cable/connector/adapter/repeater/audio/video cable etc. if any required shall be in the scope of work.
- vi. Proper dressing up of power and data cabling for all systems and devices so as not to cause interference with video signals and data networks shall be ensured by the successful vendor and shall be in the scope of work.
- vii. Multi-channel audio system with adequate number of speakers and subwoofers depending upon the capacity of visitors in the viewing area as per the layout of the area, complete with amplifier, mixer and high quality speakers etc. shall be in the scope of work.
- viii. The agency shall provide site plan document with plan, elevation and mounting details for placement of all the display units, including Transparent LED panels, multi-touch walls, LED wall, Hologram, Projectors, speakers in the visitors' area, Computer server, Content Management System for control of equipment, audio amplifier, mixer, mic and other allied system.

- ix. All metallic structures for mounting of projectors, speakers, Computer server etc shall be coated with anti-corrosive treatment and painted such that they are made inconspicuous. All safety measures shall be considered while designing for safety of people and equipment.
- x. Preparation of projection surface, if required by using teakwood frame and ply (first grade phenol bonded anti termite of century or green make) and painting the surface with multicoat of screen goo projection paint is within the scope of work.
- xi. Design and fabrication of stands for keeping and fixing the display units by using the material as specified in the BoQ shall be within the scope of work of the successful bidder.
- xii. The detailed specification of all the equipment and content is provided in Annexures I.

5. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

- i. Proposal should necessarily be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit for an amount of Rs.14.00 Lakh(i.e. 2.0% of estimated cost of the work) in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque/NEFT transfer to NCSM's bank account as per bank details provided in the term sheet. EMD instrument must remain valid for a period of 90 days beyond the final proposal/bid validity period.
- ii. Bids not accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of the requisite amount with proper validity will be summarily rejected.
- iii. Exemption of depositing EMD is allowed only to the MSME/NSIC registered bidders.

Document required for availing exemption of EMD for MSME's registered with NSIC: The following procedure is adopted for the bidders of MSME's registered with NSIC: The MSMEs who intent to claim benefits under MSME act, shall fulfil the following, otherwise they run the risk of theirbid being passed over as "INELIGIBLE" for the benefits applicable to MSME's and their bid will not be considered forevaluation.

- a. MSMEs which are specified by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises under MSME Act 2006and Public Procurement Policy, 2012 as Manufacturing/Service Enterprises should have registeredwith NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS).
- b. NSIC certificate with monetary limit indicated should be valid on the scheduled date/ extended date of submission of tender. Certificates without monetary limit will not be considered.
- c. The items of Product/ Services mentioned under NSIC certificate should be the same or similar to thetendered items
- d. The monetary limit stipulated in the NSIC certificate of MSME's should be equal or more than the value ofwork(s)/Supply is/are "In hand (Progress)" awarded under MSME benefits during the financial year plusestimated cost of this tender for availing EMD exemption.
- e. If monetary limit is less than the value of work(s)/ Supply is / are "In hand (Progress)" awarded under MSMEbenefits during the financial year plus estimated cost of this tender, they should obtain "CompetencyCertificate" from NSIC for participating in this tender as well as to avail MSME benefits. The competencycertificate should be uploaded along with the tender document.

- iv. The EMD amount shall not bear any interest payable by the NCSM to the successful bidder/un-successful bidder.
- v. EMD of successful bidder shall be retained by the NCSM which will get converted into Retention Money/ Security Deposit is submitted by the successful Bidder. Whereas, EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned after expiry of the final proposal/bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract.
- vi. EMD shall be forfeited and proposal of bidder shall be cancelled in the following cases:
 - a. if any information or document furnished by the bidder turns out to be misleading or untrue in any material respect.
 - b. if the successful bidder fails to execute the Agreement within the stipulated time as per the format of the Article of Agreement as given in this NIT document in Annexure H.

6. RETENTION MONEY/SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- i. This shall mean and be 10% of the total cost of work awarded or the final gross value of work done & paid against this contract, whichever is greater.
- ii. The Retention Money or Security Deposit will be deducted & retained @10% of the value of work done & paid through every interim bill which will be inclusive of the Earnest Money already deposited by the successful bidder along with the bid/tender.
- iii. The Retention Money or Security Deposit so retained shall not carry any interest thereon.
- iv. 50% of the Retention Money or Security Deposit shall be refundable to the successful bidder after satisfactory completion of the Defects Liability Period post actual successful completion of the work in all respect & handing over as detailed under TERMS OF PAYMENT.
- v. Balance 50% of the Retention Money or Security Deposit shall be refundable after satisfactory completion of the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract with National Museum for a period of 2 years post the Defects Liability Period of 1 year as detailed under TERMS OF PAYMENT.
- vi. In case of cancellation of the contract, this retention money shall be forfeited and amount necessary to make up this amount shall be recovered from any money due to the successful bidder under this or any other contract with NCSM.
- vii. In case, the successful bidder causes any damage to the property of the Client, the NCSM shall have discretionary rights to execute the repair of damages and recover the amount from the successful bidder or to adjust the equivalent amount from the successful bidder's Security Deposit.
- viii. In case of death of successful bidder, Security Deposit shall be returned /refunded to the legal heir of the successful bidder after adjustment of dues, if any post the actual completion

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7. JOINT VENTURES/CONSORTIUM

- In the event that the successful bidder is a consortium/joint venture formed, lead partner/prime contractor in whose name the bid was issued, shall be fully and solely responsible for the performance of contract and all works designed and executed under the contract.
- ii. Bids submitted by a consortium or joint venture of maximum two firms including lead partner, all partners shall comply with the following requirements:
 - a. The consortium as a whole must be a sound entity technically and the lead partner must be sound entity financially.
 - b. The Consortium as a whole must satisfy the qualification criteria set forth herein. The turnover of lead partner must satisfy the eligibility criteria of the tender. The bid shall contain a statement of the members of the consortium and shall provide all information necessary to satisfy Client/Employer that the Consortium fulfils the qualifying criteria.
 - c. The Bids shall contain original copy of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on Rs.100. Non-Judicial Stamp paper (or as applicable) between the consortium members clearly identifying the lead partner, scope and responsibility and financial part of each member in the performance of the contract.
 - d. The consortium members will obtain approval of the Client for any change in the shareholding structure and scope of work or any other terms of MOU.
 - e. The lead partner of the consortium shall be nominated as being in-charge to represent the Consortium in all dealings with the Client/Employer and for providing any information or clarification sought from the Consortium.
 - f. The Bid shall be signed by all the consortium firms by their authorized person. The lead partner shall be authorized to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all member(s) of the Consortium and all dealings including billing and payments, shall be done exclusively with the leader of the consortium.
 - g. Only firms or joint ventures that have been qualified under this procedure will be eligible to bid for this project.
 - h. All members of the Consortium shall be liable for the execution of the project in accordance with the terms of the MOA and Contract agreement.
 - i. Any individual bidder or member of a consortium cannot be member in another consortium and participate in this tender.
 - j. All correspondence or communications will be done by the Lead partner (or authorized representative of Lead partner) of consortium.
 - k. Net worth as on the last day of the preceding financial year should be positive during the preceding three consecutive financial years.

1. Bidder submitting their bid shall not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceeding.

Notes:

- 1. Techno-Commercial bids of the agencies that fulfil the above pre-qualification criteria shall be opened.
- 2. The bidder has to upload the compliance letter on its letterhead duly signed by the authorized signature & other supporting documents as asked for in the bid in scanned format. Failing to submit the same or non-compliance/deviation from any bid terms and conditions, eligibility criteria or technical specifications may result in rejection of the bid.

8. PROPOSAL EVALUATION / SELECTION CRITERIA

A two-stage procedure under Least Cost Based (LCS) Evaluation will be adopted in evaluating the proposals:

A. <u>Technical Evaluation:</u>

- i. Eligibility Criteria Evaluation: The technical bids will be evaluated against minimum eligibility criteria as outlined in this tender document.
- ii. Technical Evaluation: The Technical Evaluation Committee shall evaluate the PoC document/Technical Proposal.
- iii. The bidders may be called for Technical Presentations if the Technical Evaluation Committee so desires, to discuss the proposal that is submitted by the bidders in the technical bid, which can be at a very short notice of even three days.

B. Financial Evaluation

Only the bidders/firms who are shortlisted/found eligible in the technical evaluation based on Eligibility Criteria and Technical Proposal Evaluation will be eligible for their Financial Bid Opening & Financial Evaluation. A least cost selection (LCS) will be deployed for financial evaluation of the bids. Overall cost of the work will be considered for computing LCS.

During financial evaluation, the evaluation committee shall go through the rates quoted for each item and adjudge their reasonability and workability. The rates which are found to be unworkable will be treated as unresponsive and the corresponding bid will be liable for rejection.

9. COMPLETION TIME

The project/work is to be completed within **90 days** from the date of issuance of the work order/LOI.

10. <u>DEFECT LIAB ILITY PERIOD and COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL MAINTAINENCE CONTRACT</u>

- i. **Defect Liability Period (DLP) shall be of ONE YEAR** from the date of actual satisfactory completion & handing over of the entire job as certified by the authorities of NCSM/NM.
- ii. The Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) will be of TWO YEARS and will commence from the date of satisfactory completion of the Defect Liability Period.
- iii. During the Defect Liability Period and the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract Period (CAMCP), the successful bidder within their quoted rates shall service & maintain the entire façade lighting system installation with all its control units & other accessories, rectify any or all the observed defects or any or all the defects as pointed out to them within a reasonable time, as decided by the competent authority of NCSM/NM.
- iv. During the DLP as well as the CAMCP, minimum 1 visit per quarter will be given by the Service Engineer/Technician of the successful bidder for a thorough inspection, checking, repairs & maintenance of the entire façade lighting system for which all tools, tackles and material including spares as well as the required skilled/specialised manpower shall be arranged by the bidder at their expenses & risk.
- v. Apart from the routine quarterly visits as above, whenever the successful bidder is called for providing any kind of repairs/maintenance, they shall render all such services within a reasonable time, any number of times within the quoted rates and at no extra cost or expenses whether during the DLP or the CAMCP.
- vi. A register of such visits during DLP & CAMCP as well as a log-book of services rendered/major works done shall be maintained wherein counter signatures of the authorised NCSM/NM representative shall be obtained from time to time.
- vii. A penalty in the form of deduction as deemed fit by NCSM/NM authority shall be applied and be deductible from the Retention Money / Security Deposit of the bidder for any lapse in providing services, rectifying defects or in case of an inordinate delay in attending the faults/defects or responding to the service/breakdown calls.
- viii. If the successful bidder fails to rectify the defects within a reasonable time, such defects will be rectified by NCSM/NM by engaging departmental staff or outside Agencies at their discretion, and the cost thereof, as decided by NCSM will be deducted from the Retention Money / Security Deposit of the successful bidder retained by NCSM.
- ix. The bidder may separately prepare & upload a detailed scope of CAMC with other terms & conditions on their letter head which will be mutually modifiable with the successful bidder during the execution of the work and the DLP.

11. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Total Contract Payment shall be on progressive basis as per the breakup in the following table:

In case if the work is carried out in phases, total payment admissible will be computed on pro-rata basis based on completed percent of work vis-à-vis total work under consideration.

All payments, as above, shall become payable within fifteen days of submission of the respective invoices. The payment shall be transferred to the bank account of successful bidder through electronic transfer only, for which the bank details of the bidder has to be provided with each invoice.

Statutory deductions/recoveries viz. TDS, TDS GST, Labour Cess, etc. shall be made as per the relevant provisions from the payment due to the bidder from time to time.

12. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i. The successful Bidder shall submit within 3 (three) days from the date of placement of the work order the duplicate copy of the work order duly signed with official stamp on all the pages as a token of their acceptance of the work order/LoI.
- ii. In case the successful bidder refuses to accept the offer after finalisation or does not comply with sending of acceptance of the order within 03 (three) days from the date of placement of the order as per the finalised and accepted terms & conditions, earnest money deposit would be automatically forfeited and the order shall be cancelled forthwith.

iii. Penalty Clause:

In case of non-completion of the entire work within the stipulated time, and the delay is not attributable to site requirements, Liquidated Damage (L.D.) @1% per weekof the total cost of work awarded subject to a maximum of 10% of the gross value of work done or cost of work awarded, whichever is greater, shall be recovered from the bill of the successful bidder.

- iv. The authorities of NCSM do not bind themselves to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders wholly or partially without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- v. The quoted rate shall remain unchanged during the entire contract period.
- vi. The successful bidder shall be liable for depositing all taxes, levies, cess, etc. on account of service rendered by it to concerned tax collection authorities from the time to time as per extant rules and regulations on the matter.

- vii. The successful bidder shall maintain all statutory registers under the applicable laws. The bidder shall produce the same, on demand, to the concerned authority of this Office or any other authority under Law.
- viii. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be affected, as and when applicable, as per the provisions of Income Tax Act, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the bidder/contractor/supplier by this Office.
- ix. In case, the successful bidder fails to comply with any statutory/ taxation liability under appropriate law and as a result thereof this Office is put to any loss/ obligation, monetary or otherwise, this Office (National Council of Science Museums, Kolkata) will be entitled to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the Security Deposit of the Agency, to the extent of the loss or obligation in monetary terms.
- x. Before submitting the offer, bidders may visit the National Museum, New Delhi at their own cost and risk, to get an idea of actual site condition etc. which may help in designing an impressive digital experience, nature & quantum of work.
- xi. Bidders should provide the details of their local office, service centres in Delhi/NCR for after sales service and maintenance of the entire system.
- xii. The successful bidder shall be required to depute a team of qualified and experienced personnel to co-ordinate, execute and supervise all the activities from commencement till completion and handing over the system. This team of personnel will also be required to monitor the progress and review in consultation with NCSM & NM officials on a regular basis.
- xiii.Bidders should provide escalation matrix of their company for this project. Names of all the persons, contact details along with their designation should be submitted.
- xiv. Bidder should submit the details of the major projects which they have done in the last Five Years
- xv. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, in case of any dispute, claim and/or legal action arising out of this contract, the same shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Kolkata only.
- xvi. Arbitration Clause: All disputes and differences between the successful tenderer and the Council of any kind, except quality of workmanship and materials, whatever arising out of or in connection with the order on the carrying out of the work (whether during the progress of the work or after their completion and whether before or after the determination, abandonment or breach of the terms and conditions of the order) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director General, National Council of Science Museums, whose decision in this regard will be final and binding on both the successful Tenderer and the Council.

The provisions of the Arbitration and Reconciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification of the rules made there under for the time being in force shall apply to arbitration's proceedings under this Clause.




